

The city's Community and Economic Development Department today will hold a meeting about Alessandro Boulevard development.

The meeting will be 5 to 7 p.m. at City Hall at 14177 Frederick St.

Discussion will include the following, whoch are to be brought Thursday, March 14, before the planning commission:

- -Rezoning along Alessandro Boulevard to include multi-unit residential housing up to 30 units per acre.
- -Rezoning of a parcel at Gentian Avenue and Perris Boulevard from residential to commercial.
- -Creation of an Alessandro Boulevard overlay district to identify areas for multiple use districts, including residential, office and retail.
- -Creation of urban design standards for higher density development.
- -Amending the Municipal Code to include all the new standards.
